

First Period and Last Period Study Halls

This year we are giving students the option of not being at school if they have a first or last period study hall. For example, if they have a first hour study hall, they would not have to come to school until second period when they actually have their first class. Alternatively, if they have a study hall at the end of the day, they have the option to leave campus one period early. However, if they choose to remain on campus, they must be in their assigned study hall class.

For them to have this privilege, you must give your signed written permission below. Because we have to take accurate attendance, we have to have consistency throughout the entire semester. In other words, they cannot come to study hall some days and not on others. We would not know who to expect if that was the case.

By signing below, you are giving them permission to not come to study hall if it lands on the first period or last period of the day for the entire semester and you understand the school would not be responsible for them at this time. They would either be expected to come all the time or not at all.
