

SENIOR OFF-CAMPUS PRIVILEGES AND POLICY 2021-2022

<u>SENIORS AND PARENTS OF SENIORS</u>: Please review the following guidelines for *OFF-CAMPUS PRIVILEGES*. Those signing this sheet commit themselves to following the guidelines and adhering to the penalties for infractions committed <u>INDIVIDUALLY</u> or <u>COLLECTIVELY</u> by seniors.

A. Individual Students

- 1. Senior students may leave for lunch and open periods 1 & 8, or it their opens fall together as 1 & 2 or 7 & 8 on any school day. Students may leave after the bell has rung ending the preceding period.
- 2. Students may leave by motor vehicles provided that:
 - a. The school has a signed permit on file for drivers. This includes the first week of school. NO permit, no privileges.
 - b. We have this signed form on file which allows your student to ride with other seniors for lunch.
- 3. All students must return in time for class, chapels, and school assemblies. Failure to do so could result in a detention for driver and rider(s). Repeated tardies will result in withdrawal of off-campus privileges.
- 4. Students will not be permitted to congregate or loiter in the parking lot or parked vehicles. Students should leave, return, park, and leave vehicles and the parking lot **IMMEDIATELY**.
- 5. The off-campus policy is for <u>SENIORS ONLY</u>. Seniors may not take underclassmen off campus during lunch or free periods, doing so subjects them to lose their off campus privileges.
- 6. Any senior accumulating <u>FIVE</u> or more TARDIES (per semester) to the period immediately following lunch, open, and study hall periods will lose off-campus privileges for 2 weeks.
- B. The following problems as noted by area merchants or by the staff may/will result in the loss of senior lunch privileges for all seniors for part or all year. Please remind each other that "self-policing" will insure continuation of this privilege.
 - 1. Rowdy, unmannerly behavior at local business establishments including littering, reckless use of motor vehicle, etc., as reported to the school by the owner or manager of that establishment.
 - 2. Littering on campus. Fast food wrappers, bags, pop cans, etc., left or dumped on lawns, parking lots, the street in front of school, campus area, etc.

In general, students who violate items listed in section "A" above will be dealt with and punished individually.

Those problems reported in section "B" will result in loss of off-campus privileges for <u>ALL</u> seniors for a period of time determined by the administration.
