

5/6 Elective Options: 24/25

Band - 5th grade: In this class, 5th grade students will be assigned a beginning band instrument. Instrument selection will be overseen by the instructor with an effort to create a cohesive and balanced ensemble sound. Students will develop music literacy skills during class as well as perform on their instruments at required concerts outside of school hours. Musical styles will range from Christian hymns, patriotic music, and traditional band repertoire. This course is graded primarily on participation and readiness for performances. Families are responsible for supplying their student's instrument. There will be additional before or after school rehearsals the week of the Christmas and Spring programs.

Band - 6th grade: In this class, 6th grade students will build on the basic band instrumental performance skills. Instrument selection will be overseen by the instructor with effort to create a cohesive and balanced ensemble sound. Students will develop music literacy skills during class as well as perform on their instruments at required concerts outside of school hours. Musical styles will range from Christian hymns to patriotic music, and traditional band repertoire. This course is graded primarily on participation and readiness for performances. Families are responsible for supplying their student's instrument. There will be additional before or after school rehearsals the week of the Christmas and Spring programs.

STEM: Students will be introduced to principles of Science, Technology, Engineering and Math, concepts through active labs and other small group/individual lessons. The goal will be for students to gain interest in these topics through hands-on activities (including friendly competitions) that allow them to further develop critical thinking skills and creativity. Students will develop a functional knowledge in these core areas and learn new approaches to problem solving. The course is designed to encourage students to be innovative, collaborative, ethical and God honoring, while having fun!
